### Week 1: Jun 24 to Jun 28- All About Me & Gardening Basics

Kids could learn about the basics of gardening, including how to prepare soil, choose plants, and care for a garden.

### Week 2: Jul 1 to Jul 5- (closed 7/4)- Going Green

### Week 4: Jul 15 to Jul 19- Biodiversity Blast Off: The Race to the Red Planet

3-2-1 Blast off to outer space! Neil Armstrong was the first man on the moon, maybe you will be the first person to travel in a space elevator, or to land on Mars! Get ready for some fantastic physics as you calculate your best trajectory to get you there. What will you bring? How will your terra-form this inhospitable red planet? Will you create a biosphere of blue and green to provide you with fresh water and food? Will you bring Flower the Russian Tortoise, first species of vertebrae to safely complete a voyage around the moon? This week we will learn about our 8 neighboring planets and the other celestial beings orbiting in our galaxy. By studying what we know about life on earth, we can explore the possibility of inhabiting other planets and what we would need to make life there possible!

#### Week 5: Jul 22 to Jul 26- Land of the Lost: From T-Rex to Tesla

We have come a long way since our ancestors crossed the Bering land bridge over 10,000 years ago. Learn about the prehistoric megafauna that once, brave the ice age, re-live the discovery of fire and invention of the wheel, sail with the early explorers, and try your luck at panning for gold on this super blast from past to present!

# Week 6: Jul 29 to Aug 2- Wacky Science Week

Experiments all geared toward young minds. Enjoy our hands-on activities while learning about science. My Lab: Beakers, Brains- It is time to mix it up and think big! So roll up your sleeves, don your safety goggles, and dive into some kid-friendly kitchen chemistry. Using the OHEC!
